Minutes from previous meeting: Minutes from June 5, 2002 meeting were approved.

Correspondence: Received two Sherwin Williams bills for the Eyrie Gym paint supplies, which equated to \$3,615. No other correspondence was received other than catalogs and flyers.

Treasurer's Report Ed Brost was not in attendance and a Treasurer's Report was not available.
